Session and Congregational Meeting Highlights July 10 and July 15

Session Meeting - Session meetings are scheduled the second Tuesday of every month and are open to all Congregants. Those with concerns can raise them at these meetings. It was moved to request that Presbytery, as a routine matter, advise Session of the subject matter of concerns communicated to it so that Session can properly address such concerns. Discussion had revealed that this has not been Presbytery's practice in the past. The motion was seconded and passed.

Congregational Meeting - A July 15, 2012 called meeting of the Congregation of Ogden Dunes Community Church was called to order by Moderator, Reverend Phil Smith, at 9:30 a.m., for the purpose of electing a Pastor Nominating Committee. The floor was turned over to the Clerk of Session who moved that the Session's slate of candidates as follows: Rebecca Hunt, Debby Bailey, Nancy Johnson, Jacque Nagy, Butch Kleyweg, Sean Kilroy, David Larson, Jr., Ken Engel, Paul Rake and Mark Lecy be elected as the ODCC Pastor Nominating Committee. The motion was seconded. Discussion: The clerk announced that Presbytery had approved formation of a Pastor Nominating Committee at the June session meeting; that Session set the committee size at 10 and set a deadline of July 7 for additional nominations. He reported that no additional nominations were received. The motion passed. Jim Yackel, the Transitional Care Consultant will work with the committee to get things underway. The first task will be to establish a Church Information Form. Upon its approval by Session and COM, it will be published and from that point forward candidates will start submitting their interest.

My son Kristofer recently attended a Spring Hill Day Camp. Spring Hill runs high energy Christian camps led by many young people who have a heart of Christ. At the end of the session each counselor presents a Bible verse and character trait specific to the personality of each camper – a nice way to recognize each child and in many cases introduce them to a new Bible verse. 2 Timothy 1:7 was read for Kristofer and his featured character trait was Boldness.
