Congregational Survey

An April 30 meeting of the session was called to review the work of the subcommittee charged with compiling the information from the Surveys. The follow-ups from this meeting were completed and a report for the Session's approval was submitted. It was moved that the results be accepted for submittal to the Committee on Ministry with a subsequent report which will include a narrative summary for general distribution to the congregation and for the Pastor Nominating Committee's use. The motion was seconded and passed. The submittal to COM will also include summaries of the listening sessions held in March and the report of Rev. Carter on the reconciliation sessions held at the end of 2011. Upon receiving this package, Jim Yackel will fast track it to the COM for approval, and once approved we will be cleared to establish a Pastor Nominating Committee.



Book Review

If you are ready for a wakeup call from God, then it's time to read <u>The Prodigal God</u> by Timothy Keller! The front cover of the book lists the primary tenet of this writing as, "Recovering the Heart of the Christian Faith." The book itself is centered entirely on the story we usually refer to as the Parable of the Lost Son. Keller suggests the parable might better be called the Two Lost Sons!

Most of us have always assumed the word prodigal in this story means "wayward" in relation to the younger son. However, the dictionary tells us it means "recklessly spendthrift." Keller further opens our minds by taking this definition to its ultimate by surprisingly telling us, "It means to spend until you have nothing left."

The book dramatically challenges our usual concept of the "good" son and the "wayward" son. It centers on the father who represents God. As Keller wrote, "Jesus is showing us...God's reckless grace is our greatest hope, a life changing experience, and the subject of this book."
