The Pastor's Pen

As we enter the Lenten season with the focus on the Passion of the Christ, I want to consider the importance of Jesus Christ in the lives of people. Millions of people seem satisfied in their non-Christian faith. More people than ever doubt that any single religion has a corner on truth. So why do Christians insist that "Jesus is the way, the truth and the life" to God? Christianity sees Jesus Christ as the exclusive way to God—and not one of the ways to God.

Jesus Christ is the living embodiment of God's character. To discover how God acts in the world, we have to look to Jesus. As the divine incarnation of God's love and mission, Jesus exemplifies the Way of God in the world. He was with God "in the beginning" and was sent into the world, not only to tell us about God, but to demonstrate how God wants us to live.

How does God want us to live? The short answer is that God calls us to love one another: "Let us love one another, for love comes from God...Whoever does not love does not know God because God is love" (1 John 4:7,8).

The affirmation of Jesus as "The Way" means that He shows us who God is and how God acts in the world. All roads do not lead to God. The Way of Jesus is the Way of love, the Way of humility and self-denial for the sake of others. Denial of the uniqueness of Jesus makes null and void his redemptive work He accomplished on the Cross.

Furthermore, "Jesus is the Truth." He is the Son of God and the living embodiment of truth. Jesus is categorically different from all religious leaders in every other religion. He is <u>not</u> a mere Teacher, a Prophet, a Messenger from God - rather, He is the Son of God. Jesus was with God at Creation. "Through Him all things were made...In Him was life and that life was the light of all people." (See <u>John</u> 1:1-5)

In Jesus, truth is not abstract, intellectual or moral but personal and relational. Other religious leaders point us to the truth of God, but Jesus is Truth itself.

Finally, Jesus is not only the Way, the Truth, but He is also "the Life" (John 14:6).

Every religious leader has died. There is no claim of a

Resurrection. But Jesus did not only die, and was buried, but He rose again from the dead on the third day. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father. Jesus conquered Death at Easter. He is the Supreme Lord of Life and of Death.

As a result, Christianity does not propose one more way to God or another way of enlightenment. Rather, it claims exclusivity that Jesus Christ is the Son of the living God, and that "He is the Way, the Truth and the Life." He is not a distant God, immune to the human condition. Jesus suffered immeasurably on humanity's behalf. He is the <u>only</u> way to Father God. Trust Him today! Recommit your life to Him! He loves you with an everlasting love.

May the blessing of the Lord be upon you during the season of Lent!

In reality, it isn't remorseful at all. The root word for "repentance" is the Greek word *metanoia*, from which our word "metamorphosis" comes. The great image of this is the butterfly emerging from its cocoon; the caterpillar being transformed into new life.

No one is remorseful about that! Nor should we be with repentance, which involves leaving the past and emerging into new life.
