Can we fathom love? German researchers observed 279 men and women from their childhood to adulthood; from ages 3 to 19 and made a startling discovery. The scientists visited the children at home and noted how the parents reacted when the children cried, screamed, threw temper tantrums, etc. Towards the end of their study, the researchers took blood samples and found that the children (now young adults) whose parents were harsh, strict and impatient, lacked two things which protected them from heart attacks and strokes. On the other hand, with those who had a loving relationship with their parents, the protecting substances were present. A warm-hearted relationship also resulted in the formation of more receptors for stress hormones. Those who were lovingly cared for by their parents complain less of fear as adults, were less hostile and aggressive and dealt with pressures more easily.

I believe that this study reveals the power of the words: "I love you!" Nothing is better than Love. Nothing is greater than Love. Love touches hearts. Love changes lives. Love brings encouragement, comfort, hope, overcomes aggression and inspires confidence. Love does not mean overlooking sin but Love "loves" in spite of the sin.

Here are a few thoughts to think about:

- Love is not blind—it sees more, not less. But because it sees more, it is willing to see less.
- The loneliest place in the world is the human heart empty of love.
- Anybody can be a heart specialist. The only requirement is loving someone.
