

The Pastor's Pen

You know that there's nothing glamorous about an iron bar. The raw material isn't particularly attractive, isn't worth much and isn't hard to come by. Not many people would steal a bar of iron, which (I am told) is worth about \$5.00. But the value of that bar changes if you put it to work. For example, if you refine the bar, hammer it into horseshoes, and sell the horseshoes, it could bring about \$50.00. Or better still, if you fashion it into a piece of sculpture, it could be worth \$5,000.00. Or better still, take the iron bar and forge it into tiny springs used in precision watches, it could be worth about half a million dollars.

Nothing about the iron bar has changed. How it is handled and **put to use is what makes it so valuable.** In a similar way, hundreds of men were executed through crucifixion in the time of Christ. Nothing happened. But when another Man—Jesus was crucified, everything happened. Time changed from B.C. to A.D. Humanity's sins were paid in full. It was "God in Christ reconciling the world unto Himself..." (2 <u>Corinthians</u> 5:19) Jesus was not just a Man but the GOD—MAN!



A Window Into The Word

- In 2 <u>Samuel</u> 13:19, "ashes on the head" was typical of deep shame and mental anguish as well as repentance and sorrow.
- In <u>Job</u> 13:12, the ashes represent references made by Job's friends to the glory which he once had, but now had lost. It served as a reminder of his former position of power and wealth, which had now become a pile of ashes.
- In <u>Malachi</u> 4:3, ashes is used to describe the utter and complete defeat of everything in this world that is of the Devil. The Lord will destroy the works of the Devil and will cause His people to triumph through Christ.
