"God's Peace"

The beloved hymn "It is Well with My Soul" has been a source of comfort to many. The hymn was written in memory of the author's four daughters who had just perished in a shipwreck and his wife barely rescued. Through it all, the couple maintained their faith in their sovereign God and wrote this hymn through their broken hearts and wellspring of tears:

When peace like a river attendeth my way, When sorrows like sea billows roll Whatever my lot, Thou hast taught me to say, It is well, it is well, with my soul.

The truth of the matter is that our faith in God does not dehumanize us. God has not promised us a life of ease, free from heartaches and tragedy; but He has promised to be with us:

"When you <u>pass thru</u> the <u>waters</u>, I (the Lord) will be with you; <u>Thru the rivers</u>, they will not overflow you; <u>thru the fire</u>, you will not be burned..." (Isaiah 43:1-3)

The prerequisite for "the peace of God which passes all human understanding" (Philippians 4:6 – "Be anxious for nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God." Also, Isaiah reminds us: – "God will keep his/her in perfect peace whose mind is resting on your God."
