The hymn "It Is Well With My Soul" was written in memory of the author's four precious daughters who had perished in a shipwreck and his wife barely rescued. Through it all, the couple maintained faith in the sovereignty of God and would say through their tears:

When peace like a river attendeth my way, When sorrow like a sea billows roll, Whatever my lot, Thou hast taught me to say, It is well with my soul.

Our Lord has not praised us a life of ease, free from heartache and tragedy, but He has promised to be with us.

God knows you by name. <u>Isaiah</u> 43:1 reminds us: - "The Lord has called you by name; you are Mine (He says)."
