## Pastor's Weekly Devotional – September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 "The Love of God"

I was walking past a boutique recently and a sign in the window caught by eyes. It said: "I love you more!"

Immediately I was reminded of God's love in <u>Jeremiah</u> 31:3- "I (God) have loved you with an <u>everlasting</u> love" – and to me that word "everlasting" can relate to the sign in the window: "I love you <u>MORE!!</u>"

The truth is that God loves you with everything He has. He does not love you less when you sin or have failed or disappoint Him. His love for you is constant, steadfast and unshakeable. Because God's <u>Nature</u> is <u>Love</u> (I <u>John</u> 4:8).

In fact, the scripture teaches us that God has shown His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8).

Here is something to think about. No matter what wrong you did yesterday, regardless of what wrong you may do today – and God who knows all "the wrongs" you will do in the future, that does not diminish His love for you. Somehow or the other, the display at the window was right except that God's love for you has no expiration date and it is inclusive and He will forever "love you more!"
