### **“Something Different”**

God is no kill-joy. Jesus' first miracle was at a wedding. He turned water into wine. Proverbs 15 reminds us that “a merry heart makes a cheerful countenance...and has a continual feast” (vv. 13, 15). But here's my favorite one: “A merry heart is like a good medicine...” (17:22).
