"Miracle and Mystery"

"Behold, the virgin will be with child and bear a Son, and they shall call His Name "Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us." (Matthew 1:23)

G. Campbell Morgan, a great bible expositor, said of Christmas: "Here is the Ancient of Days becoming a Babe in Bethlehem. Here is He who thunders in the Heavens, crying in a cradle. Here is the One who made all flesh now being made of flesh. Here is He who summoned the legions of angels wrapped in swaddling clothes...the Mighty God becoming a helpless child."
