

In a national study from the Office of Applied Studies, Substance Abuse Mental Health Services reports:

- Drug or alcohol abuse among persons aged 18-25 is almost three times higher than all persons.
- The highest mortality rate from drug overdose occurs in tho: 18 to 25 years of age.
- One in every four homes has a family member struggling wi substance abuse.
- Northwest Indiana Quality of Life Indicators report 80% o all Indiana prison inmates report a history of substance abuse
- Porter County Drug Task Force reports 2009 Statistics:
 - > 22 overdose fatalities
 - More than 233 requests for an ambulance due to potential overdose
